Background and Purpose of Introducing ANDPAD

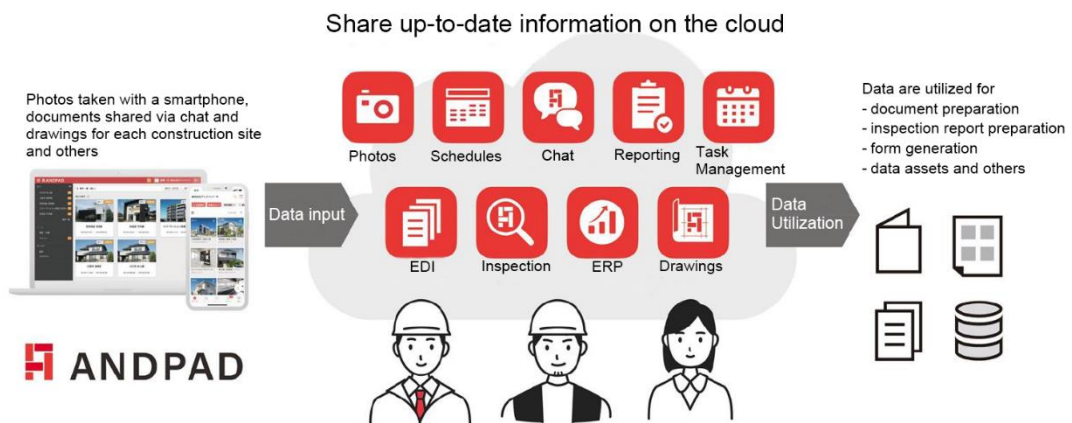
